Building and Zoning

This week in the Building and Zoning Department:

- Final development plans for the six unit residential project on Oak Street have been received and are under review by the city's development team.
- The city's inspector has been monitoring and inspecting the wall construction at the new surface parking lot site.
- Several applications have come in for residential projects, including fences, additions, HVAC replacement, solar projects and interior alterations. As well as multiple residential inspections taking place on various ongoing projects around the city.

Finance

Saturday, the carpet will be replaced in the utility/finance offices at City Hall, as we continue to make needed improvements to the building. This work will result in the offices being closed a portion of Monday morning as desks and file cabinets are put back in place. Special thanks to our public works crews who have been moving quite a bit of furniture lately prepping for the carpet and getting our new Assistant City Manager's Office together for his start next week.

Public Works

ODNR and Prus construction met this week at city hall to discuss their progress on the replacement of the O'Bannon Creek Bridge along the Little Miami Scenic Bike Trail. Substantial progress has been made, particularly on the north side of the bridge, where the installation of the concrete approach and wooden rails have been completed, along with a significant amount of the grade work including hydroseeding. On the south side, preparations are underway for pouring the approach to the bridge. With anticipation building for the scheduled May 24th dedication, this project remains firmly on track to finish on time.



Progress on the East Loveland Avenue Bridge Replacement project continues to advance as significant milestones are achieved. The contractor has installed the new bridge footers, marking a crucial phase in the project's development. Furthermore, the scheduled delivery and installation of the box culvert for the new bridge is set for today. Concurrently, the Metropolitan Sewer District (MSD) maintains steady progress with the installation of the new sanitary sewer line.

Public Safety

LPD's Local Diaper Drive starts this Sunday. All diapers received through the program will be donated to the Care Center, located at Northstar Church. LPD's support of the Care Center makes a difference in the lives of families in the community.
