

Memorial HISTORY



The City of Loveland's Veterans Memorial was founded in 1992 and is overseen by the Veterans Committee. Its plaza features pavers reserved for 9,000 individualized, permanent commemorations. All veterans, alive or deceased, from Loveland or elsewhere, who have ever served in any branch of the United States Armed Forces, may be honored on these pavers. The memorial is located at the crossing of West Loveland Avenue and Riverside Drive.
