### **ARTS COMMISSION**

Establish guidelines and oversee public art displays to promote and involve the community in visual and performing arts.

### **BEAUTIFICATION COMMITTEE**

Design, organize and implement landscapes that enhance the appeal of our city. Annual events include spring & fall planting.

### **BOARD OF TAX REVIEW**

Hear appeals made by residents dissatisfied with any ruling or decision related to city tax.

### **BOARD OF ZONING APPEALS**

Hear appeals related to decisions and variances involving the Planning & Zoning Commission.

### **CIVIL SERVICE COMMISSION**

Oversee rules and regulations for the city's classified employees.

### **COMMUNITY IMPROVEMENT CORPORATION (CIC)**

Serve as the city's development branch by promoting industrial, economic, commercial and civic development of Loveland.

### **FINANCE COMMISSION**

Provide oversight of annual operating budget.

### **HILL-WAGONER CEMETERY PRESERVATION COMMITTEE**

Advise City Council on the preservation, general operation, and maintenance of the Hill-Wagoner Cemetery.

### **HISTORIC PRESERVATION & PLANNING COMMISSION**

Approve construction appropriateness and establishes guidelines for the city's designated historic district.

### **LIGHTING DISTRICT EQUALIZATION BOARD**

Hear objections regarding the assessment of real estate within a special lighting district.

### **LAW & ORDINANCE COMMITTEE**

Review proposed laws and ordinances prior to City Council's review.

### **PARKS & RECREATION BOARD**

Guide the development, maintenance, and operation of recreational facilities and programs.

### **PLANNING & ZONING COMMISSION**

Assist with regulations covering the platting of land.

### **STORM WATER COMMITTEE**

See that the city is maintaining its Storm Water Plan for cleaner streams and rivers.

### **TAX INCENTIVE REVIEW COMMITTEE**

Review all tax incentive programs administered by the city to enhance economic development.

### **TREE & ENVIRONMENT COMMITTEE**

Recommend the development of practices that provide environmental and economic prosperity in our community. Annual events include Free Tree Giveaway and river clean-up.

### **VETERANS COMMITTEE**

Assist in planning of events and oversee the memorial paver and banner programs. Annual events include the Memorial Day Parade & Ceremony.
