Public Works Tackles Another Snow Event

#### Administration

As part of our ongoing commitment to maintaining and improving City Hall, several offices and the main hallway received new carpeting this week. In addition to the flooring upgrades, the Building and Zoning Offices were repainted, giving the space a refreshed and updated look. To minimize disruptions and ensure operations continued smoothly, staff remained adaptable throughout the process, temporarily relocating their workspaces to the Council Chambers and other available areas.



Thursday, I had the privilege to attend the Love Our Land Awards event, where community members were recognized for their contributions to improving the city's natural environment. Among the many that were recognized for their unselfish work towards bettering the city's environment, were the Valentines Ladies. Special thanks to our hosts for the evening, former committee member Mike Meldon and current Tree and Environment Committee member, Doug Gilbert.

Thursday evening, Assistant City Manager Chris Wojnicz, Chief Michael Gabrielson, and Assistant to the City Manager Misty Clark attended the Kiwanis Club of Greater Loveland meeting at The Landing. Kiwanis International is working to re-establish a club in the Loveland area and has been actively engaging with local organizations, including the school district, chamber of commerce, library, LIFE Food Pantry, NEST, and others, to generate interest and support for the initiative.

#### Building and Zoning

Activities this week in the Building and Zoning Department:

- Several inspections took place on multiple homes in various states of construction in Chimney Ridge. One of the homes, 21 Paxton, was completed this week and passed their final. The CO was issued.
- The permit is ready to issue for the rebuild of the home at 1208 W. Main St.
- A sign permit was issued for Verizon, 10565 Loveland Madeira Rd.
- The grading permit is ready to issue for 271 E. Kemper Rd.

#### Public Works

This week, Public Works staff responded to winter weather conditions by treating roadways multiple times to ensure safe travel. Crews first applied treatments on Sunday night to combat snow and ice, followed by additional applications on Wednesday morning, Wednesday night, and into Thursday morning as winter weather persisted.

Beyond winter weather response, team members also took part in an in-house training session on Wednesday covering Traffic Control Procedures for Roadway Work Part 4. This training reinforces best practices for maintaining safety and efficiency during roadway projects.

#### Public Safety

The Loveland PD received delivery on a new E-Bike. The bikes have become an excellent tool for the department during community events and within city parks.
