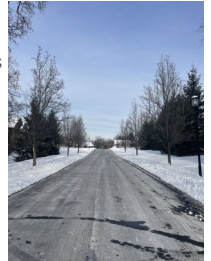
City Council Recognizes Director of Finance Mark Medlar on 5 Years of Service to the City

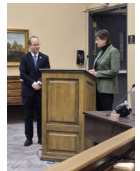
### Public Works

### Finance

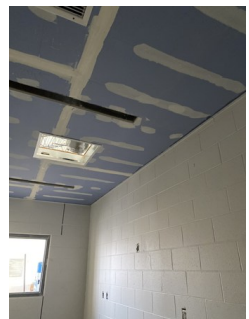
